- The Tuckshop is open on Thursday.
- Our Tuckshop Convenor, Debbie Lee, is a parent volunteer and needs other parents to be on roster for tuckshop to operate. Tuckshop volunteers need to sign that they have read and understood the Student Protection Volunteer Handbook.
- All 1st break and 2nd break lunches must be pre-ordered on Wednesday.
- We do not run an IOU system, so we would appreciate payment at time of ordering.
- How to place an order.....

Please write your order on a brown paper bag with child's NAME and CLASS. Please state First Break or Second Break. Please use separate bags for each order. Please NO orders on envelopes or plastic bags as this adds time to the sorting process. Fold bags together with payment enclosed, there is No need to wrap coins or use rubber bands, sticky tape or staples.



- If you are aware of any dietary requirements for your child please advise the tuckshop when placing your order.
- If any order is unavailable, a substitution will be made after checking with the child concerned (where possible).
- Any Change will be wrapped and placed in child's bag with order.
- If ordering for more than one child, payment would be appreciated in the individual's order, however if it is necessary to pay for the orders together, please place all the orders together and have one child hand in the orders. This makes it easier to ensure payment for all children have been made and the necessary change returned.
- Lunch orders are to be collected from the tuckshop at the beginning of each lunch break. However Prep lunches are delivered to the Prep room.
- Ice Blocks can be purchased after eating time at 1st lunch break.
- We have a Term menu that is sent home at the beginning of each term and available on the school website.

Parents on roster are reminded that no children are allowed in the tuckshop as this is a food preparation area. Ipswich City Council Health Department recommends that children should not be in this zone.

All tuckshop volunteers must sign in and out at the office on all occasions.
